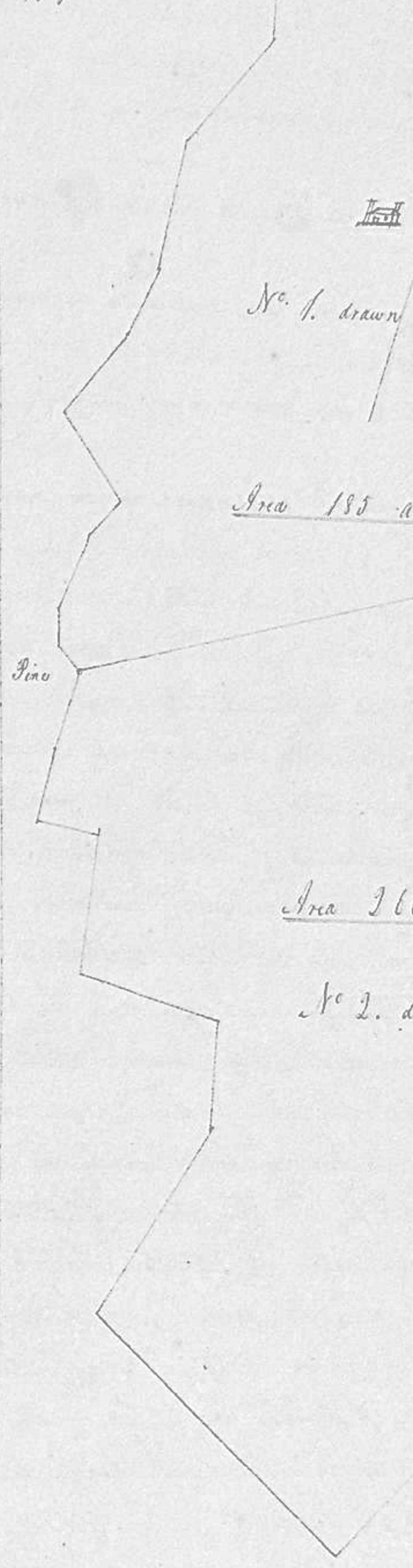
This day came the parties by their counsel and the Commissioners appointed under an arbitrary decree, made in this cause, at September Court 1835, to divide the real estate of Bird Harrell decd., made the following Report. "According to a Decree of the County Court of Southampton bearing date September Court 1835 and herewith annexed we have proceeded, accompanied by the County Surveyor to divide the real estate of Bird Harrell decd., and have divided the home Plantations into two divisions and have divided the Tuckers Swamp Plantations into two divisions also as will appear by referring to the annexed Plot. we have estimated each division of the home plantations to be worth one hundred dollars more than the division of the Tuckers Swamp Plantation. Patrick B. Harrell drew Division No. 2. at Tuckers Swamp and William Harrell drew division No. 2. of the Home Plantation in consequence of which the said William Harrell is to pay unto the said Patrick B. Harrell the sum of one hundred dollars. Ransom G. Harrell drew division No. 1. of the Home Plantation and James Harrell drew division No. 1. of the Tuckers Swamp Plantation in consequence of which the said Ransom G. Harrell is to pay unto the said James Harrell the sum of one hundred dollars. Given under our hands this 4. day of May 1836. Benjamin Drew. Robt. Pritlow. Calvin Milford."
