

said Jynes shall keep the peace & be of good behavior towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth for the term of 12 months from this day then this recognizance to be void.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb settle Saml. Calvert's Guardianship of James Miller's orphans and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

On motion of Lewis A. Branch, ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb settle an account of Walter G. Brattle's administration on the estate of Peggy Washington's estate and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb settle an account of Stephen M. Jackson's administration of the estate of Littleberry Mason decd. and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that a Commissioner of this Court settle an account of John Drake's administration on the estate of Elizabeth Drake decd. and make report to this Court, with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

✓ For reasons appearing to the Court, the order heretofore made restraining the late Sheriff from paying to Jeremiah Cobb & Clements Rochelle the sum of five hundred dollars in part service for building the Court house of this County be rescinded, and that the said Sheriff pay the said Cobb & Rochelle the said sum.

Ordered that the accounts of John Wilson amounting to \$2.64 cts and the account of William Davis amounting to \$2.07 cts be certified to the auditor of public accounts for his examination and payment.

On the petition of William L. Everett for leave to open a new road from the Naylor's Bridge road from some point south of the Flat swamp bridge & to run to Bigkins Bridge Rail Road Warehouse; it is ordered that the said petition be referred to Henry B. Baughan, Thomas B. Norrell and William H. Nicholson, three of the Road Commissioners of this County and that they report thereupon according to Law.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to-morrow morning, Ten o'clock.
