Whereupon the said Everett Edwards together with Richmond Edwards and Jonas Edwards his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to Wyndham Robertson Esq. Lieutenant Governor, and acting as Governor, of the Commonwealth of Virginia that is to say, the said Everett Edwards in the sum of two hundred dollars and the said Richmond Edwards and Jonas Edwards in the sum of one hundred dollars each of their respective goods and chattels, Lands and Tenements to be lived and to the said Lieutenant Governor & his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition, that if the said Everett Edwards shall personally appear before the Judge of the Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery for this County at the Court house on the first day of the next Term, to stand his trial for the felonious offense of which he stands charged and shall do and perform what the said Court shall order & direct and shall not depart without the leave of the said Court then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.

Albrigton Edwards who stands charged with feloniously stealing, taking & carrying away on the 7th day of May 1836 from the store of William Mallory, in the Town of Jerusalem, one orange, some lemons & raisins of the value of ten cents, this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County. Whereupon on the motion of the prisoner, the examination is adjourned till the next. And thereupon the said Albrigton Edwards together with Richmond Edwards & Jonas Edwards his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to Wyndham Robertson Esq. Lieutenant Governor, & acting as Governor, of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the said Albrigton Edwards in the sum of one hundred dollars, and the said securities in the sum of fifty dollars each of their respective goods & chattels, Lands and Tenements to be lived and to the said Lieutenant Governor & his Successors for the use of the said Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Albrigton Edwards shall make his personal appearance before the Justices of the County of Southampton at the Court house on the first day of July Court and stand his trial for the offense aforesaid of which he stands accused and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force.
