Albington Edwards, who stands charged with feloniously stealing, taking and carry-
ing away on the 7th day of May 1856 from the stand of William Mallory in
the Town of Jerusalem, one orange, some candy & Raisins of the value of two cents.
This day appeared in court in discharge of his recognizance entered into at the last
Court, and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County and sum-
ary Writings were sworn and examined and the prisoner was fully heard by Counsel.
The Court from all the circumstances of the case are of opinion and so accordingly order
that the prisoner be tried for the said offence at the next Quarterly Court to be held
for this County. And thereupon the said Albington Edwards together with Richmond Edwards
& Jonas Edwards his securities, here in Court, severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted
to Myndham Robertson Esq. Lieutenant Governor, and acting as Governor, of the Commonwealth
the said Albington Edwards in the sum of fifty dollars and the said Richmond & Jonas
Edwards in the sum of twenty-five dollars each of their respective Lands & Tenements,
goods & chattels to be levied and to the said Lieutenant Governor and his successors
for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said
Albington Edwards shall make his personal appearance before the Justices of the County
Court of Southampton at the Court house on the first day of August Term next to
stand his trial for the offence of which he stands charged and shall not depart
thence without leave of the Court then this recognizance to be void.

Ordered that John Moore be surveyor of the road from Halsenburg's mill to the forks
of the road near David D. Saragis and that the Lands of Anthony M. Howell, Eliza-
beth Johnson, Jethro Cobb, Brittan Bryant, James Johnson, George Camp, Randolph Fowler,
Samuel Robertson, James D. Halsenburg, Spikes Beal, Willis Johnson, James Johnson (of Eliza-
beth) Harrison Beal & the Lands of the said Moore do work thereon.

On motion of Allen Edwards who made oath and together with Joseph Seneca and James Se-
now, his securities, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thou-
sand dollars conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters
of administration de bonis non with the Will annexed of William Wells dead in and
forms.

Davis Barrett is assigned Guardian to Margaret & Julia Anna Bachus orphans of Richard
Bachus, and thereupon the said Davis Barrett together with John Barrett and Thos. B. Howell
his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars
conditioned as the Law directs.

Ordered that the estate of Cordy Whitfield decd. be committed to the hands of Benjamin
Griffin Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.

Ordered that John C. Beal, Miles Story and Henry Jones, being first sworn before a ju-
stice of the Peace for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of Cordy
Whitfield decd. and return the appraisement under their hands to this Court.
