

Agastin Pope administrator of Jesse Barrett decd.

This day came the parties by their counsel and the commissioners appointed under an interlocutory Decree of this Court, made in this cause, at the February Court 1826, make the following report which is ordered to be received. Pursuant to an order of Court a copy of which is hereto annexed, as the undersigned have on the 9th day of March 1826, carried the foregoing decree into effect in manner therein directed, 1st by laying off and setting apart one third of the Land of which Jesse Barrett said decd. and his wife Rhoda Barrett, her dower in the same. Lastly sold as by the said tract of Land including the occasion dependant upon the said dower estate with the negro slave Rose, and the said Rhoda Barrett Widow and relief as aforesaid became purchase of both Land and negro Rose. Thence it became necessary to describe the bounds of her said dower right in the said Land; for which tract of Land she gave three hundred and fifty dollars, and for the said negro Rose she gave two hundred and fifty two dollars, from which we have taken one per cent. our commission, which leaves \$596 dollars and of which amt. we have deducted and allotted to the said Rhoda sixty two dollars and fifty cents, the same being one fourth part of the proceeds of the sale of said negro Rose in line of her interest therein. The remainder being \$533 dollars and 60/100 which amt. we have divided into five equal parts and have taken five separate bonds of the said purchaser with approved security to each which bonds Lewis Merrill one of us subject to the further order of the Court. And furthermore we have audited, stated and settled as hereto annexed Jesse Barretts guardian acct. with his two Nephews (to wit) Louisa Merrill and Mariaisa Merrill, as well also Agastin Popes acct. of administration on the Estate of Jesse Barrett decd. which acct. is also stated and hereto annexed, by which statements, as stated, we find the said Agastin Pope in debt to the above named Louisa Merrill the sum of four hundred dollars and fifty four cents same to carry interest from Decr 31st 1823 till paid also we find the said Pope in debt to Mariaisa Merrill only nine cents to carry interest as aforesaid, and furthermore we find said Pope administrator of Jesse Barrett decd. as aforesaid in debt to said decdents estate the sum of Five hundred and thirty three dollars and eighteen & 3/4 cents, the said sum to carry interest from Nov 18. 1823 till paid: — which proceedings we respectfully submit to the Court. Given under our hands this 9th day of March 1826. Lewis Merrill. Jacob Barnes. Jesse Barrett. Whereupon by consent of parties, the sale and division as aforesaid, in manner and form as aforesaid, it is agreed and ordered to be firm and stable, and binding between the parties.

An Indenture of bargain & sale from William Story & Polly his wife and Sally Wick to John Margrave, was proved by the oath of Dardens M. Bryant & Benjamin E. Vick two of the witnesses thereto as to said William Story & Sally Wick and together with the certificate annexed of the spury examination and acknowledgment of the Wife, ordered to be continued.

An Indenture of bargain & sale from Alfred Story and Dicy his wife to John Margrave, was proved by the oath of Benjamin E. Vick and Dardens M. Bryant two of the witnesses thereto as to said Alfred Story and together with the certificate annexed of the spury examination and acknowledgment of the Wife and continued.
