Ordered that the Estates of Walter Carroll, Caroline Carroll, Patrick Carroll, Sarvinia Carroll and Mary Frances Carroll orphans of John Carroll decd. be committed to the hands of Benjamin Griffin, Sheriff of this County, who is appointed Curator to preserve & the estates of said orphans.

Ordered that David D. Sarago, guardian to Emma Cooper, orphan of John Cooper decd. be authorized to expend Twenty five dollars of the principal of said Mares estate, for her support.

On motion of George Gay, guardian to Susanna Gray ordered that the said guardian be authorized to expend Twenty dollars of the principal of said Mares estate for her support.

Ordered that Benjamin Griffin Sheriff and Curator of the Estate of Walter, Caroline, Patrick, Sarvinia and Mary Frances Carroll orphans of John Carroll decd. be authorized to expend Twenty five dollars of the principal of said orphans estate for their support.

The last Will and Testament of Elias Love decd. was proved by the oath of William Spirey and Robert M. Hart, Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And Peter Booth the Executor therein named, being dead, on the motion of Jesse L. Bailey who made oath and together with Lewis A. Branch, William C. Bailey and Matthew Sheriff his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, testificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of said Elias Love with his said Will annexed in due form.
