The last Will and Testament of Peterson Pope decd, having been heretofore proved by one witness, was fully proved by the oath of Richard Darden a witness thereto and ordered to be recorded And on the motion of Jacob Williams, the only executor named in the said Will, who made oath and together with Richard Porter and Drury Bittle his securities, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Three thousand dollars, conditioned as the law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.
