consideration whereof the Court doth approve, order and decree that Solomon Daughtry executor of Matthew Gardner
and renders before William M. Jones, Jesse Parker and Joseph J. Lawrence or any two of them, who
are for that purpose appointed Special Commissioners, an account of the sales of any of the slaves
of Matthew Gardner, made by him (except Isaac and Jacob) which account they were to make up,
charging the said Solomon Daughtry with the value of the slaves sold by him (with the exceptions aforesaid)
And that the said Commissioners, or such as may act in their stead divide the amount of the said slaves
and the unsold slaves of the said Matthew Gardner, so as to set apart and allot one third of the said
slaves and money to Samuel R. Gardner, Nelson B. Gardner, Samuel Daughtry and Samuel Daughtry ex-
ecutors of Miriam V. Gardner and Solomon Daughtry and his wife Barbara, that they proceed to di-
vide the sd. third part so allotted into four equal shares and allot $\frac{1}{4}$ to Sam. R. Gardner, $\frac{1}{4}$ to
Nelson B. Gardner, $\frac{1}{4}$ to the executors of Miriam V. Gardner and the other $\frac{1}{4}$ to Solomon Daughtry
and his wife Barbara, having regard to quality and quantity in making such division, and
that they make report of their doings and doings in order to a final decree. But the parties
admitted as aforesaid before they take the benefit of this order, if required by the exec. of Matthew
Gardner shall execute to him refunding bonds as the Law directs

An Inventory and Appraisement of the estate of Rhoda Powell decd. was returned and ordered to be
recorded.

An Account of James Senow's Guardianship of Jacob Senow was returned, and the Court approving and
confirming the said Report, doth order the same to be recorded.

An Account of James Senow's Guardianship of William & Elizabeth Boykin was returned and ordered
to be recorded. And it is ordered that said Guardians pay to the father of the said infants, for
their benefit the balances due them respectively on said accounts.

the Auditor of Public Accounts, for his examination and payment.

Witness thereto and continued.

Ordered that James Maget, William Owens and Edwin G. Hart or any two of them let to the lowest
undertaker the repairs of the bridge across Allen's Mill Pond, receive the same when completed and

Ordered that Matthew Joyner, Jesse Lankford, and Leam Bowers or any two of them let to the lowest
undertaker the repairs of Black Rock Bridge, receive the same when completed and make report
thereof to this Court.

The Commissioners of Roads to whom was referred the application of Jesse Lankford, for leave to open
