

Bias Edwards in his last Will and Testament, they having power to sell one or more of the same if necessary, into five equal parts, and distribute the same, as follows, one fifth part to the Plaintiff Sarah Edwards, one other fifth part to the Plaintiff Elizabeth Edwards, one other fifth part to the Plaintiff Maria Edwards, one other fifth part to the defendant William Edwards and the remaining fifth part to the defendant Margaret Edwards - And that they make report of

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine state and settle an account of Nathaniel Williams's administration on Aubin Middleton's estate and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that the sheriff, out of any contingent monies in his hands pay to the administrator of David Edwards the sum of \$1.50 for services rendered by the said Edwards in his lifetime as a patroller and also pay John Moore one dollar for his services as a surveyor of the Road.

This day this cause came on to be heard on the bill, answer and exhibits and was argued by counsel, on consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that Everett Bryant, Eorum Bryant or either of them be Commissioners, to sell the lands that George Williams holds as tenant by the courtesy in right of his Wife upon the said George Williams relinquishing all right to the said Land by producing a certificate under his hand and seal - as well to the highest bidder on a credit of twelve months the land that George Williams holds as tenant by the courtesy, and that they take three bonds of equal amount, one bond they pay to the guardian of Richard Williams, one bond to the guardian of Margaret Williams, the other bond to Hannah J. Williams and that they make a deed to the purchaser. And make report to this Court in order to a final decree

Ordered that the sheriff summon all the Justices of this County to the next Court, to appoint a Commissioner of the Revenue for Nottoway Parish in the room of George G. Gray decd.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until the first day of the next Term.
