

any the time and place of sale at various places for at least ten days before the sale, so sell to the highest bidder on a credit of twelve months (except so much as will be required to pay the cost of said one of the sale, which will be in cash, and to be paid over by the commissioners to those entitled thereto) the slaves James, Mary, Mary and his child Georgiana in the Bill mentioned taking from the purchaser or purchasers bonds with good security and in such way as to be able to distribute the proceeds as hereinafter directed, that the commissioners who may act pay over to said Thomas Atkins & Sally his wife $\frac{1}{3}$ of the nett amount of sales, to be held by them absolutely, in lieu of his life estate in said slaves - Secondly, divide the balance into five equal shares and allot and pay over $\frac{1}{5}$ to Stephen B. Washington, $\frac{1}{5}$ to the Guardians of Elizabeth Ann Washington, $\frac{1}{5}$ to the Guardians of Benjamin Gregory Washington & $\frac{1}{5}$ to be equally divided between said Stephen, Elizabeth Ann, Benjamin Gregory Washington and the said Thomas Atkins and wife Sally: and the commissioners are directed to make report in order to a final decree. Liberty is reserved to the infant defendants to show cause if any they can, within one year after they arrive to 21 years of age.

This day came the parties by their counsel and the commissioners appointed to act under an interlocutory decree pronounced in this Court September Court 1836 made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows "Agreeable to a decree of the County Court of Southampton bearing date September Court 1836 we Patrick Rowe and Bennett Griffin two of the commissioners appointed by the Court for that purpose, after giving thirty days notice of the time and place of sale sold to the highest bidder the above lands which Elizabeth Mills held in lands of her first husband, Willis Turner dec. for the sum of sixty-five dollars, and after paying the necessary expenses left a balance due of forty nine dollars and forty three cents which we divided in four equal amounts, and taken bonds from the purchaser - one to Allen Edwards as Guardian of Eley Davis's children and one for Patsy Thomas and two William Harris's kids. This 16th day of January 1837. Patrick Rowe Bennett J. Griffin." Whereupon, by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the sale aforesaid in manner & form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and binding between the parties.
