Williams and Henry Hendrick his securities, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Gilbert H. Neal decd with his Will annexed in due form.

Ordered that Ethelred Smith, Josiah Norrell, Alexander Myrick and John Barnett or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace, for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of Gilbert H. Neal decd and return the appraisement under their hands to this Court.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Charles Monmons decd. was returned and ordered to be recorded.
