This day came the parties by their counsel and the commissioners appointed to act under an interlocutory decree pronounced in this cause, at December Court 1836, made their Report, which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows: "In obedience to a Decree of the County Court of Southampton, bearing date December Term 1836, and hereto annexed, we the undersigned have proceeded to divide the lands in Southampton and Sussex of William L. Rochelle decd as therein directed, and do report to your Honors viz. - In Southampton we allotted to John M. Williamson and Ann T. his wife formerly widow of William L. Rochelle decd three hundred and eighty seven acres as her dower in Lands in both Counties, - and to Robert Rochelle in Southampton, seventy nine acres, Nathaniel Land in right of his wife Mary formerly Mary Rochelle, eighty acres and to Stephen Mordaugh Jan. ad litem to the heirs of Nathaniel Rochelle decd eighty acres. And in Sussex, we allotted to Robert Rochelle one hundred and seventy acres, to Nathaniel Land one hundred & fifty acres, and to Stephen Mordaugh Guardian, as aforesaid one hundred and seventy acres, all of which is respectfully submitted. Given under our hands this 11th day of February 1837. Geo. A. M. Newsom. Basham Mearns. Henry Pattway. To 1 day services as commissioners in dividing the aforesaid Tracts of Land at \$5 per day each of 6000." Whereupon, by consent of parties, it is decreed and ordered that the divisions aforesaid in manner & form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable, and forever binding between the parties.
