By the Commissioners. John Brown. John Mercer. John S. Boykin. January 14th 1837.
Whereupon, by consent of parties, it is decreed and ordered that the sale & division aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and forever binding between the parties.

Ordered that Carr Bowers, James Holmes, Jonathan Sankford and Joshua Whitney or any three of them, being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose, do appraise all the the personal estate of John Corbett decd & return the appraisement under their hands to this Court.

On the motion of William L. Everett for leave to alter the road called Holy Bridge Road running on the lands of Britain Scarborough accd. ordered that the application be referred to Thomas B. Norrell & William A. Nicholson two of the Commissioners of Roads of this County, and that they view and report thereupon according to law.

John M. Williams is appointed Surveyor of the Cobham Road in the room of William L. Norrell who has removed. And it is ordered that the usual taxes work thereon.
