This day came the parties by their counsel, and the Commissioners appointed to act under an interlocutory decree pronounced at June Court 1856, and an amended decree pronounced at September Court 1856, in this cause, made their Report which is ordered to be recorded, and is as follows, "Subsequent to an order of Court for the County of do. Ampton made at its September term 1856, ordered that James Jackson, Willie Francis & Henry Moore do make sale of the one fifth part of the personal estate of Sally Scarborough decd. and agreeable to said order we the Commrs. did proceed to sell on the 27th day of October for cash Virginia money which sold in the aggregate for the sum of two hundred and nineteen dollars 38 cents which we distributed as the order directs: after deducting six dollars for the Commissioners charges, to wit, to the guardian at Law of Lucy Ann Scarborough one hundred and seventy seven dollars eighty two cents & to Margaret G. Nicholson the sum of thirty five dollars, fifty six cents seven under our hands this nineteenth day of December one thousand eight hundred and thirty six. James Jackson, Willie Francis, Henry Moore." Whereupon, by consent of parties, it is decreed and ordered that the sale and division aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and forever binding between the parties.

Ordered that William D. Hood Esqrs M. Shields and Mills Millons being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace, for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate estate of Robert Coombs decd and return the appraisement under their hands to this Court.

On the motion of Josiah Joyner who made oath and together with Patrick Boles John Wick and James Wells, his securities, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Matthew Joyner decd in due form.

Ordered that Jno. Moore Sr. John Davis, Patrick Rowe and Matthew Drake or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of Matthew Joyner decd and return the appraisement under their hands to this Court.

On motion of Nicholas J. Barham who made oath and together with Jesse L. Bailey and James C. Little, his securities, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Priscilla B. Barham decd in due form.
