Ordered that Benjamin Isaac, Richard Holcomb, Henry Strong & the hands of Doct. Nicholas A. Schell do work on the road of which John Scarborough is Surveyor.

On the petition of Joniaki lobb for leave to alter the Road near Mrs. Bells, ordered that the application be referred to any two of the commissioners of Roads for this County and that they view and report thereupon according to law.

The commissioners appointed to let the enclosing of the Public Square, this day made a verbal report stating that they had agreed with the undertaker to make an alteration in the work of fencing from the original plan and that they have agreed to allow the said undertaker an additional sum of Fifty eight dollars making in the whole six hundred dollars which the undertaker is to receive for the work according to the plan now agreed upon; and the Court approves of the said alteration and additional allowance.

Ordered that The Court be adjourned until the first day of the next Term.
