

plaintiff may have execution against the defendants for the sum of seventy five dollars and eighty six cents, the penalty of said bond, and the cost by him in this behalf expended. And the said defendants in mercy &c. But this execution may be discharged by the payment of thirty seven dollars and ninety three cents with legal interest thereof from the 11 day of January 1807 till paid and the cost.

On the motion of James Jackson administrator of Joshua Cummings decd. Ordered that the sum of \$25.50 be placed to the credit of the said Jackson in addition to the credits allowed him in his account of his administration of the said Cummings's estate as reported by Commissioner Cobb, the sum being the amount paid by said Jackson as administrator of Joshua C. Cummings as aforesaid to John W. Mason in discharge of a judgment in favor of said Mason.

On the motion of Edwin Harrison who made oath and together with Henning T. Smith and Harrison Cobb, his securities, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs his certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of William D. Simmons decd. in due form.

Ordered that Edwin D. Hart, Ethelreda Warren, Leonard Cobb and Harrison Cobb or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of William D. Simmons decd. and return the appraisement under their hands to this Court.

Robert Ridley is assigned guardian to Benjamin, Edgar & Lucinda Mocham orphans of James Mocham decd. and thereupon he, together with Thomas Ridley Jr. his security, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

James Doyal orphan of Wilkins Doyal, with the approbation of the Court, made choice of John M. Gurley for his guardian and thereupon the said John M. Gurley together with Henry Blaw and William A. Spark his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Henry D. Bailey orphan of Joseph Bailey decd. with the approbation of the Court, made choice of James Clayton for his guardian, and the Court doth assign the said James Clayton guardian of Nancy D., Robert J., and Joseph M. Bailey orphans of said deceased; and thereupon the said James Clayton together with John Brown, his security, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of eight hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Henning T. Smith is assigned guardian for Edwin Parker orphan of Hanson Parker decd. and thereupon the said Henning T. Smith together with John D. Hart, Edwin Harrison and Harrison Cobb his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

John Brown is assigned guardian for Dicy M. Bailey orphan of Joseph Bailey decd. and thereupon the said John Brown together with James Clayton his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs.

On the petition of James James, who produced the sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by law and entered into bond with Henry Morris and William D. Jones, his securities, in the penalty of one hundred and fifty dollars conditioned as the law directs, a license is granted him to keep an ordinary at his house, in this County till May Court next. The Court being satisfied that the said James James is a man of good character and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming.

On motion of Joseph S. Cloud, ordered that Charles Commissioner Cobb examine, state and settle an account.
