And thereupon the said Henry Porter together with James Mills and David Robinson his securities here in court acknowledged themselves to be indebted to David Campbell Esq Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia: that is to say the said Porter in the sum of fifty dollars and his said securities in the sum of twenty five dollars each of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements to be liened and to the said Governor and his Successors in Office for the use of the Commonwealth vendors. But upon this condition that if the said Henry Porter shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of the Commonwealth more especially towards the said David Campbell for the term of twelve months from this day, then the above Recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the peace for this County to the first day of August Court next to recommend fit and proper persons to be added to the Commission of the peace of this County.

On motion of Isabel a free negro woman. Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the peace of this County to the first day of October term next to hear the petition of the said Isabel for leave to remain in this County according to law.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Henry Joyner decd was returned & ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
