Ordered that Master Commissioner both examine state and settle an account of John Lowe's administration on the estate of Ann Lowe decd and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

John C. Beale, a nephew of Rebecca Beale who has lately died intestate, moved the Court to grant him the administration on the estate of said Rebecca Beale. Whereupon Simon the husband of a sister of said decedent appeared and opposed the motion and moved the Court to grant him the administration on the said estate. The Court after hearing the parties by their Counsel is of opinion that administration on the estate of said Rebecca Beale be granted to said John C. Beale upon the said John C. Beale executing bond with good security in the penalty of Five Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. From which opinion of the Court the said Simon Murphy prayed an appeal to the next Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery for this County, which is granted him he having given bond with Allen Edwards his security in the penalty of Fifty dollars conditioned as the Law directs.

Ordered that Solomon I. Parker, Joseph Blanton and Barham Menn or any two of them, do examine, state and settle an account of River Parker's Guardianship of William Manry and make report thereof to this Court.

Ordered that the estate of Sally Telt's decd. be committed to the hands of Benjamin Griffin Sheriff of this County, for administration according to Law.

Ordered that Samuel B. Hines Samuel T. James and Zebulon Simmons being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Sally Telt decd. and return the appraisement under their hands to this Court.
