Jane West, Henry Newton, Sally Jey, and Richard Barmer, who were recognized to appear to the Court summoned for the examination of Chatham Barmer charged with felony which Court failed to meet were this day solemnly called but came not, therefore it is ordered that they be summoned to the next Court to show cause if any they can why a writ should not be sued out upon their said Recognizances.

Barrett Brier & al. against Mary J. Harrison. Motion. John A. Darden who has been summoned to appear here this day, as a Witness the plaintiff, was solemnly called, but came not. Therefore on the motion of the said plaintiff, it is ordered that the said John A. Darden be summoned to appear here on the first day of the next Court, to show cause, if any he can, why he should not be fined for his said contempt.

It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court, that the plaintiffs are not residents of this State on the motion of the defendants by their attorney, it is ordered that this suit be dismissed, unless security for the payment of such cost and damages as may be awarded the defendants and also the fees which will become due from the plaintiffs to the officers of this Court, be given with the Clerk within sixty days from this time.

Parsons Turner, who stands charged with feloniously cutting on the 15th June one Tom Smith of this County with intention to maim disfigure disable or kill the said Tom Smith, was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County (the Court summoned for his examination having failed to meet) and for reasons appearing to the Court the examination of the said Parsons Turner is adjourned till the next Court, and thereupon the said Parsons Turner is remanded to jail.

Nicholas M. Schrell a Justice of the Peace in this County returned a Recognizance entered into by George Johnson for his appearance here this day to answer the complaint of Mason Johnson against him, for a breach of the peace, and thereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the said recognizance is continued until the next Court.

Thomas Johnson who stands bound by Recognizance for his appearance here this day to answer the complaint of Mason Johnson against him for a breach of the peace, appeared in Court in discharge of his Recognizance, and for reasons appearing to the Court, the case is continued till the next Court. And thereupon the said Thomas Johnson is committed to the custody of the Sheriff to be confined in the common jail for the County, until he shall enter into a recognizance in the sum of one hundred dollars and two securities in the sum of Fifty dollars each for his appearance at the next Court to answer the complaint aforesaid.

Solomon D. Parker a Justice of the Peace in this County returned a Recognizance entered into by Mylie Hickory and William Mallory & John A. Newson for the appearance here this day of said Morris, to answer the complaint of John R. Maller against him for a breach of the peace, and for reasons appearing to the Court the said recognizance is continued until the next Court.

On the petition of James Maget praying for relief as security of Henry S. Williams for his Guardianship of the person of James Milliken decd. This day came the parties, who being heard, it is ordered that the said Henry S. Williams give the said James Maget good counter security. And the said Henry S. Williams refusing to give the security required it is ordered that he be displaced from the office as Guardian as aforesaid.

Williams Briggs appointed committee of the estate of the said Thomas Johnson, and thereupon the said Williams Briggs acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars.

James Maget a Justice of the Peace for this County for ten dollars for a fine one half of which is to be paid by the said James Maget and the other half of said judgment to be accounted for.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Webb execute a writ of habeas corpus on the estate of Elias C. (partient by himself, or which he may be required to state).

Ordered that Master Commissioner Webb execute a writ of habeas corpus on the estate of William Wells decd and make report thereon to the next Court, or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Webb execute a writ of habeas corpus on the estate of Elizabeth Wells decd and make report thereon to the next Court, or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the next Court, the minutes of the foregoing Court being read.
