Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine state and settle an account of Allen Edwards and William V Edwards's Co-administrators (proceeding) on the estate of Elias Edwards decd and report the same to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine state and settle an account of Allen Edwards's administration on the estate of William Wells decd and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine state and settle an account of Allen Edwards's Co-administrators (proceeding) on the estate of Elizabeth Mills decd and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to-morrow morning at 9 o'clock
