

in this cause at the November Court 1836. made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows "In Dec. 1836, your commissioners proceeded on the 14th day of January 1837 to make up the account referred to in the annexed decree, from the vouchers and accounts rendered by the said Solomon Daughtrey executor of Matthew Gardner decd. Your commissioners proceeded first to estimate the value of the unsold slaves namely.

being one third of the valuation of the sold and unsold slaves: we then placed negro boy Jo valued at \$700 with \$233 1/3 in lot No 1. Also Robertson and Fanny with \$32.50 1/3 in lot No 2. and Olivi, Peter, Isaac & Sarah with \$11.25 1/3 in lot No 3. Whereupon the plaintiff in the suit drew Not. and as a division among the heirs of said decd. could not be effected without a sale of the boy Jo it was agreed by the parties that Solomon Daughtrey the executor should take the boy at our valuation that is \$700 upon which the following statement was made.

We then divided the above balance of \$626.83 1/3 into four equal shares making the sum of \$156.71 each of the heirs, Whereupon the defendant Solomon Daughtrey executed bonds payable to the parties respectively for the aforesaid sum of \$156.71 in which were included, at the request of the parties the sum of \$56.43 the balance appearing to be due each of the heirs upon a settlement of the executorial acc. of said decd. with the estate of Matthew Gardner decd. making the sum total of \$213.14 we then delivered to Lemuel Vaughan exor of Uriah B. Gardner decd one of these bonds and to Nelson B. Gardner one each for the aforesaid sum of \$213.14 with Nelson B. Gardner security to the former and Lemuel Vaughan security to the latter, and they executed refunding bonds at the Law direct. But Lemuel B. Gardner refused to receive the bond made payable to him in consequence of which we now return the bond with our report to the Court to be filed therewith. All of which is respectfully submitted. Given under our hands the 14th day of January A.D. 1837. Wm Jones, Joseph Lawrence. Whereupon by consent of parties it is ordered and decreed that the distribution aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid be held firm stable and forever binding between the parties.
