Absent - James Maget - Present Jeremiah Cobb Gent.

Ordered that the accounts of Jeremiah Stephenson amounting to \$3.08 and another amounting to 63 cents - one in favor of John Thomas amounting to \$2.04 - and one in favor of David Newson amounting to \$4.29 be referred to the auditors of public accounts for his examination and payment.

John A. Edwards Clerk of this Court thirty five dollars are allowed him for his services in examining and settling the books of the Commissioners of the Revenue this year.

Be it remembered that Parsons Turner, Nathaniel Simmons and James Stronch here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to David Campbell Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia and his successors in office, the said Parsons Turner in the sum of two hundred dollars and the said Simmons & Stronch in the sum of one hundred dollars each of their respective goods and chattels lands & Tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Parsons Turner shall make his personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery on the first day of the next term to stand his trial for the felony for which he stands charged for feloniously cutting on the 15th of July last one John Smith of the County of Southampton, with intention to maim disfigure disable or kill the said Smith, or to answer an indictment to be preferred against him for the felonious offence aforesaid, then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

Chatham Barmer of the County of Southampton, who stands charged with burglariously & feloniously on the 28th day of May last (passed in the night time of that day at 6 o'clock, in breaking open and entering the dwelling house of Jane West of said County & stealing taking and carrying away from thence the sum of \$11.87 placed in silver of the property of said Jane West, was set to the bar in custody of the sheriff of this County. And thereupon summary witnesses were sworn and examined and the prisoner fully heard by counsel - on consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court & accordingly ordered that the prisoner be discharged from further prosecution for the said supposed offences and thereupon he is discharged from custody.

Myatt Bird & al. against Mary Jane Harrison - Motion. On the motion of the defendant this cause is continued till the next Court, at her cost.

James Sherris is assigned guardian to James A. Boykin orphan of Isaac B. Boykin decd and thereupon the said James Sherris together with Nathl. Williams and Gregory Blitt, his securities, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the Court directs.

On the motion of John A. Darden the rule against him for not attending at the last term as a Witness for Myatt Boyard & al. against Mary J. Harrison, is set aside.

On the motion of Jane West, Henry Newton and Richard Barmer the rule against them for not attending at the last term as Witnesses for the Commonwealth against Chatham Barmer is set aside.

The summon awarded against Sally Boy at the last term to show cause why a writ of habeas corpus should not be issued against her upon her recognizance entered into by her for her personal appearance to give evidence on behalf of the Commonwealth against Chatham Barmer charged with felony, being returned executed the said Sally Boy was solemnly called but came not therefore it is ordered that a writ of habeas corpus against the said Sally Boy upon her recognizance aforesaid returnable here at the next Courts.
