For which and the said Burwell Everett hath executed several bonds with Caleb Everett security therefor the sum of six hundred dollars & 6⁶/₇ each payable the 9th day of Oct. next one to Allen Hill in right of his wife Martha late Torgerson & one to Matthias Tomlin in right of his wife Nancy late Torgerson, one to William Torgerson one to Benja Beat in right of his wife Elizabeth late Torgerson one to Peter Torgerson, one to Benja Beat guardian to Joshua Torgerson, and one payable to the Comrs. for the benefit of Richard, Sylvia & William infants of William Barden and wife Mary admt of Torgerson making the sum of

Whereupon by consent of parties, it is hereby ordered that the date & division aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid be hereinafter set forth and forever binding between the parties

Allen Hill in right of his wife Martha late Torgerson, Matthias Tomlin in right of his wife Nancy late Torgerson, William Torgerson, Benja. Beat in right of his wife Elizabeth late Torgerson, Peter Torgerson, Williams Barden guardian ad litem to Richard, Sylvia & William infants of the said William & Mary Barden, late Torgerson now admt of Joshua Torgerson infant son of Barth Torgerson by Benja Beat their next friend & Dft. In (sic) against

David Bryant admt of Barth Torgerson, died.

This day came the parties by their counsel and the Commissioners appointed to act under an interlocutory decree pron-

ced in this cause at the December Court 1836, made under a decree of the Chancery of Southampton and place of sale was on the 9th day of October next the lands of which Barth Torgerson died were purchased by four hundred & sixty one dollars Deduct attorney's fees & court's charges & commissions which sum of \$138.32 the Comms have a Barden bonds with Davis Bryant & Caleb Everett 9th day of October next to the following ones to Allen Hill in right of his wife Torgerson, one to William Torgerson, and the other share or seventh share and David Bryant & Caleb Everett's next to the Comr & the benefit of said and Mary his wife late Torgerson Thomas Everett (dead) Jas. Magr. That the sale and division aforesaid binding between the parties.

Ordered that the court be adjourned.
