a Justice of the peace for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of Nancy T. Reese decd and return the apprais-
ment under their hands to this Court.

A bill of Sale from Temperance Norrell, Thomas B. Norrell, Lewis Norrell, Josiah Norrell and Robert S. Barnes to Aman-
da M. Norrell, was proved by the oath of John E. Deal as to Robert S. Barnes and acknowledged by said Thomas B.
Norrell & Lewis Norrell, and the same having been proved in the Clerk's office on the 18th day of September 1837 as to
said Barnes by the oath of William Owens, was ordered to be recorded as to said Thomas B. Norrell, Lewis Norrell
and Robert S. Barnes and continued as to the other parties.

On the petition of James C. Little and Joseph S. Bailey (spraying) for relief as securities of Nicholas J. Barham for his due
and faithful administration of the estate of Priscilla B. Barham decd. This day came the parties by their attorneys who
being fully heard, it is ordered that the said Nicholas J. Barham indemnify the said James C. Little and Joseph S. Bailey
by executing a new bond in the penalty of Twenty five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. And thereupon
the said Nicholas J. Barham together with Henry Ellis and Samuel Barham, his securities, entered into and acknow-
ledged a bond payable to the sitting Justices in the penalty (prescribed) and conditioned as the Law directs.

James M. Gardner who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here this day to answer the complaint of
Mary Gardner his wife against him for a breach of the peace appeared in discharge of his recognizance, and there-
upon the said Mary Gardner and James M. Gardner being fully heard and sundry witnesses being sworn and ex-
amined. The Court after hearing the testimony are of opinion and therefore order that the said James M. Gar-
ner give security for his keeping of the peace for the term of twelve months from this day, the said James M.
Gardner to be bound in the sum of Five hundred and two securities in the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars each and
that the said James M. Gardner pay the cost of this prosecution. And the said James M. Gardner is committed to the
hands of the Sheriff to be confined in the Common Jail of the County until the said security be given, or until he be discharged by
due course of Law. - And it appearing to the Court during the investigation of the case that a felony has been committed
it is therefore further ordered that the Sheriff take the said James M. Gardner before a Justice of the peace for this Coun-
ty to be dealt with according to law.
