



Should not be ruled to give the said Allen Edwards good counter security -

Ordered that the account of Benjamin Griffin Sheriff amounting to \$3.75 Cents and the account of Jesse Drury amounting to \$52.01 Cent be severally certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination and payment in lieu of the accounts certified at October Court last.

Ordered that the Estate of Mary Drake deceased be committed to the hands of Benjamin Griffin Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.

Ordered that Benjamin Dunn Edgington Janyer, and Henry Blaw being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Mary Drake deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of a Subst Janyer a legatee in right of his wife, in the Will of Edwin Reese decd. It is ordered that Rebecca Reese Executrix of the last will and Testament of the said Edwin Reese be summoned to appear here in the first day of the next Term, to show cause, if any she can, why other good security should not be required of her for the performance of her duties, or her power as Executrix as aforesaid is revoked.

Ordered that the estate of Benjamin Miller deceased be committed to the hands of Benjamin Griffin Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.

Ordered that the Sheriff procure two stoves for the use of the jail of this County and cause them to be erected therein and present his account to this Court.

Ordered that Thomas C Jones do contract with some one to affix shutters to the windows of the jail of this County and make report thereof to the Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until tomorrow morning ten o'clock.
