and under the interlocutory decree rendered in this cause at June Court last, this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit "We the undersigned Commissioners acting under the within decree, did on the eighth of July last sell at public auction the lands ordered by the within decree to be sold, of which said land Susan Hines became the purchaser at one hundred and forty three dollars, for which sum she has executed four bonds, one to each of the legacies for the sum of thirty five 75/100 dollars - Thomas D Brown, Wm Parker, H A Adkins." Whereupon by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and binding between the parties forever -

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Thomas D Brown, William Parker and Howell A Adkins Commissioners to Susan Hines was acknowledged by the said Howell A Adkins one of the parties thereto to be his act and deed -

The Court doth assign James Seaborn guardian to William A Musson orphan of William C A Musson deceased and thereupon he together with John W Mason and Joseph T Cloud his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

On the motion of John A Person who made oath and together with Peter Edwards his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Mary A Person deceased in due form -

On the motion of Guthbert D Barham who made oath and together with Sampson C Reese and John Barham his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Frances Rochelle dec'd in due form -

Ordered that Sampson C Reese, John Barham, Henry Stoddard and Edward Beaton or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose to appraise all the personal estate of Frances Rochelle deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court -

The Court doth assign John A Person guardian to his infant child Mary Elizabeth Parsons, and thereupon he together with Peter Edwards his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen thousand dollars conditioned according to law

Martha Allen, Hester Mary, William and John Murfee infant children of Burwell Murfee by Littleton R Edwards, guardian ad litem appointed by the Court to represent them in this behalf

This day this cause was docketed by leave of the Court and consent of parties, and came on to be heard on the bill and answer and was argued by Counsel. On mature consideration whereof the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that James A Magel, Sept Denny, and Tetah Ellsworth be appointed Commissioners, any two of whom may act that they sell to the highest bidder at auction, the two tracts of land whereof the late Polly Murfee died seized to wit.
