The Commissioners appointed to view the Cypress Bridge and report whether it should be repaired or rebuilt this day made the following report "Virginia Southampton County Court In obedience to an order made by the Court of said County appointing Lemuel P. Nicholson, Henry Blaw, Shadrack Tuttle, Amos Stephens and John W. Thomas to examine the Cypress bridge and report to the Court what repairs there should be put to said bridge or whether it should be rebuilt - We Henry Blaw, Lemuel P. Nicholson, and Shadrack Tuttle have examined said bridge, and think it very necessary there should be a new bridge erected - Very respectfully submitted. Lemuel P. Nicholson, Henry Blaw, Shadrack Tuttle, 18 December 1887." Whereupon the Court doth order that Lemuel P. Nicholson, Shadrack Tuttle, Henry Blaw and John W. Thomas or any three of them do view and report whether in their opinion the said bridge may not with convenience to the public as well as to individuals be removed to some other place across the said river, and upon the propriety of building the said bridge upon piles -

The Court doth assign Josiah Joyner guardian to Jane, Allen and Stevenson Joyner orphans of Matthew Joyner deceased, and thereupon the together with Thomas Joyner, Elizabeth Joyner, and Matthew stills his securities entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

Copies of the Registers of Richard Whitfield and Bob Smith foremen, were examined and certified to be correct.

Accounts of Joseph J. Clancy's guardianship of Evelyn Clancy, Elizabeth Clancy, Mary Clancy and Marjorie Clancy were severally returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Thomas Ridley Jr. setting forth that he is bound in this Court as security for Robert Ridley as guardian of Benjamin, Edgar and Lucinda Mauchon orphans of James Mauchon deceased and that he conceives himself in danger of suffering by reason thereof and praying the Court for relief. It is ordered that the said Robert Ridley be summoned to appear here forthwith to show cause if any he can why he should not be ruled to give the said Thomas Ridley Jr. good counter security. Whereupon the said Robert Ridley appeared in Court and acknowledged due notice of this motion, and the Court after hearing the parties are of opinion and do accordingly order that the said Robert Ridley give the said Thomas Ridley Jr. good counter security the bond for which purpose is to be in the penalty of one thousand dollars, and conditioned for the entire indemnity of the said Thomas Ridley Jr. against any loss or damage already sustained or which he may hereafter sustain in consequence of his Securityship aforesaid. And the said Robert Ridley here in Court refusing to give the said security it is ordered that he be displaced and removed from his office as guardian aforesaid.

On the motion of Asahel Joyner in right of his wife who is named as a legatee in the will of Edwin Reese deceased against Rebecca Reese Executrix of the said Edwin Reese decd. the summons against the said Executrix at the last Court awarded being returned executed she appeared in Court in obedience thereto, and the said Asahel Joyner and wife and the said Executrix being fully heard and it appearing to the Court that the Securities
