This day came the parties by their counsel and the Commissioners appointed to act under an interlocutory decree pronounced in this case, made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows: "In obedience to the above order, the Commissioners do hereby certify, that we met at the house of Edward B. Bland and viewed the following negroes between John M. Reed wife formerly Batham and J. Batham having reference to quality as well as quantity, and allotted to J. Batham Sam. Auga, Pelfield & Louisa to John M. Reed in right of his wife, Milla & Chica Lanning, Till and Nancy, Given under our hands this 23rd day of Decr 1833. Benja Williamson. Wm. Jones Secs. N.B. Milled also certify that Thomas P. Smith acted with us and did before signing this Report Benja Williamson. Wm. J. Jones." Whereupon by consent of parties it is agreed and ordered that the division aforesaid in manner as aforesaid be held firm and stable and forever binding between the parties.

The unexpired term of the license which David Gedwin was licensed to keep having been transferred to Edwin & William Harrison, on the motion of the said Edwin & William Harrison who with John Hardaway & Littleton show their securities entered into and acknowledge a bond in the penalty of one hundred and fifty dollars conditioned as the law direct a license is granted them to keep an inn or boarding house at their house in Jerusalem until the next day of May Court next. The Court being satisfied that the said Edwin & William Harrison are men of good character and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming.

The Commissioners heretofore appointed to let to the lowest bidder the repairs of the Bridge across Holloway Swamp, this day made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows: "Pursuant to an order of the County Court of Southampton we the undersigned did first give notice of the time and place, and then let to the lowest undertaker the building of a bridge across Holloway Swamp, which was undertaken by Thomas Doyal for the sum of twenty nine dollars and fifty cents and has been completed agreeable to contract. And we did further act by selling up and selling the old planks and timbers, which sold for one dollar and fifty two cents which sum we paid over to said Thomas Doyal in part of the new bridge which bears the sum now due him of twenty seven dollars and ninety four cents - which is respectfully submitted to the Court. Given under our hands this 1st day of December 1837. John Moore Secy. Thos. Newcomb Secy."
