This day came the parties by their counsel and the commissioners appointed to act under an interlocutory decree pronounced in this cause at October Term 1836. made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows "The land above mentioned in this decree having been surveyed and the commissioners have divided said land as follows, having had regard to quality as well as quantity, - House Lot (No 1.) being drawn by James Westbrook containing 100 acres - middle lot (no 2.) being drawn by William Westbrook, containing 127. lower lot (no 3.) being drawn by Thomas H. Westbrook containing 131 acres which together with this report we return a plat of the said land from the Surveyor, which will more fully show which we humbly submit to the Court.
