Ordered that Master Commissioner Webb examine state and settle an account of Benjamin Beale's Guardianship of Joshua Tugason and make report thereof to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that the Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of the Appomattox Bridge, do let to the lowest bidder. Taken the rebuilding of the said bridge, receive the same when completed and make report thereof to the Court.

Ordered that Benjamin S. Drew, Edwin Milford and Josiah D. McKel, or any two of them, do let to the lowest bidder the repairs of Tappan Bridge, receive the same when completed and make report thereof to the Court.

Copies of the Registers of Harriet A. Bailey, Charles Milton and Elijah Davis free negroes, were examined and found to be true and correct.

Ordered that William R. Edwards be appointed to furnish fuel for the stoves in the Court House.
