Brister were sworn as Grand Jurors of the County of Southampton and having received their charge, withdrew and after some time returned into Court, and having nothing to present were discharged.

Ordered that the account of Philip J. Claude's administration on the estate of John Claude decd. be committed to the Commissioners, who reported it for him to reexamine, restate and settle the same and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

In motion of Randolph R. Gardner guardian of Mary & Louisa T. Gardner, Ordered that he be allowed to expend fifty dollars of principal exclusive of the interest, for the support & education of each of the said wards.

An account of William Parker's Guardianship of John A. Turner with a receipt thereon, was returned and ordered to be recorded.

In the petition of John Mercer for leave to alter the Road running near his house; the persons appointed to view the way for this day made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows "In obedience to the above order, we the Commissioners John Brown, Samuel H. And upon consideration thereof, the Court are of opinion and therefore order that the petitioner have leave to alter the road as proposed and that the old road be discontinued from the time the new road is opened and put in good repair.

Ordered that the account of Nathaniel Frances's administration on the estate of Robert M. Hart decd. be committed to John Lebb who is directed to reexamine, restate and settle the same and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Nicholas Lebb decd. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The Commissioners heretofore appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the small bridge across the gut at Lower Seabrook this day made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows "In obedience to the annexed order, we the Commissioners, James Clayton, John Bowers & Patrick Does, appointed by the County Court of Southampton to let the repairs of the little bridge across the gut at Lower Seabrook, have proceeded to let the same after giving twenty days notice thereof, and Benjamin Lounsell became the undertaker for eleven dollars and twenty four cents.
