Beale: That he divide the money which shall arise from the sale of the "Anna James Tract" into seventy eight parts and allot or assign 47 parts thereof to the complainants as executors of Elliott Whitehead deceased: 47 parts to the defendant Leontine Judkins; 7 parts to the defendant Thomas B. Beale; 7 parts to the defendant William C. Beale; 7 parts to the defendant Harriet C. Beale; 7 parts to the guardian of the infant defendant Margaret B. Beale; 7 parts to the guardian of the infant defendant Armin I. Beale, and the remaining 70 parts to the guardian of the infant defendant Jesse D. Beale: And that the said Commissioner, make a report of his proceedings to this Court in order to a final decree. Liberty is however reserved to the infant defendants to come in after they shall attain full age and set aside this decree on showing good and sufficient cause therefor.
