Twenty five dollars part thereof she paid in cash, out of which we have paid the costs in this case incurred - the balance of said twenty five dollars we retain as ours for our personal trouble - the further sum of two hundred and eighty dollars we took bonds for and paid them over as by the said decree we were directed, which proceedings of ours, we respectfully submit to the Court - Given under our hands this 19th day of March 1838. Thomas Everett, Mary Maget." Whereupon by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the sale aforesaid in manner and form aforesaid made, be held firm and stable forever -
