 of the appraisement of all the said negroes. 4. the said Elizabeth Turner shall pay to James Turner lots
 the sum of twelve allan 37/2 to make his lot equal with hers 5. the said Elizabeth Turner shall pay
 to Narcissa Newsum the sum of thirty seven dollars & fifty cent to make her lot equal with hers. Given
 under our hands this 10. day of April 1838. Wm A. Jones. Nathaniel Francis. Thereupon by consent
 of parties by their counsel it is agreed and ordered that the division aforesaid in manner and form as
 aforesaid, be held firm and stable, and forever binding between the parties.
