This day came the parties by their counsel and the Commissioners appointed to act under an interlocutory decree pronounced in this cause at November Court 1835, made their report, which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows. "In pursuance to an order of Southampton County Court November 1835 we the undersigned Commissioners divided the lands belonging to the estate of David Westbrook Junr. dec'd according to the within speech of the Surveyor. Given under our hands this 16th day of Feb'y 1838. Jos. T. Claud. Wm. A. Jones. John Drury.

Below is a Plan of the land of which David Westbrook dec'd specified surveyor for a division by a decree of Southampton County Court under direction of Commissioners: the boundaries running as follows commencing at a black gum in the Gum Swamp and running S 47° E 16.12 poles to a bl. gum thence S 49° E 5.68 to a Spanish oak. thence N 56° E 37.12 Red oak N 83° E 9.16 N 85° E 16.66 N 79° E 8.28 N 89° E 19.20 a corner of Neely, Drew and Jos. T.
