This day came the parties by their counsel and the Commissioners, appointed to act under an interesting decree pronounced in this cause at October Court 1832 and amended at January Court 1837, made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows to wit: "Agreeably to the within decree the undersigned as surviving Commissioners have executed a Deed to Calvin J. Stephenson the purchaser, for the lands sold (pursuant to the decree made October Court 1832. John S. Swanton, Allen Stephenson)." Whereupon by consent of parties, it is decreed and ordered that the sale aforesaid be held firm and stable and binding between the parties.

On the petition of Patrick Dole for leave to open a new Road - the viewers this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded and is as follows to wit: "In conformity to the annexed order of Court the undersigned, having (after being duly sworn) viewed the route where it is proposed to open a new Road - say from the Seacocks Road near Patrick Dole's to Tucker's Swamp Meeting House - We have in the first place seen all the persons on whose Land the road is proposed to be opened and all of them have consented to let said Road be opened free of any damages, whatever, in consequence of which no inconvenience can result to any person: and as to the advantages that will result to a number of individuals, will be considerable - the proposed Road does not only lead to a public meeting House, but leads to another road, which crosses Blackwater river, and goes on to Isle of Wight Court House and thence to the Town of Smithfield. There are a number of families that will be materially benefited by opening the Road as proposed above. Respectfully submit to the Court. Jos. H. Council. Benjamin. James S. Jones. May 1838." And it is ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the next Court to consider the propriety of granting the said Dole leave to open the said Road as proposed.

A Deed of Bargain & Sale from James C. Peters to Lucy Parker was acknowledged by said Peters to be his act and deed and ordered to be recorded.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of David Westbrook decd was returned and ordered to be recorded.

A Deed of bargain & Sale from Lucy Parker to James C. Peters, was proved by the oath of Solomon D. Parker and John M. Tiller two of the Ministers thereto and continued for full proof.

On the motion of William Mallory, Merchant, he is hereby permitted to retail spirituous liquors at his store in this County it appearing to the Court that he is a man of good character and that the place is fit and convenient for the neighbourhood.

On the motion of James C. Peters who made oath and together with Solomon D. Parker & Henry Pettway, his co-adjutors, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Rebecca J. Barrow decd in due form.

Ordered that Solomon D. Parker, John M. Tiller, Joshua Briggard and John L. Barham or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Rebecca J. Barrow
