

Ordered that the Sheriff collect from Edwards Watts the sum of fourteen dollars and five cents and account thereof to the Court.

Ordered that the account of John R. Williams amounting to one dollar thirty eight cents be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination and payment.

The Commissioners appointed to let the rebuilding of the Cypress bridge this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit: "Southampton County June - 1838. In obedience to an order of the County Court of Southampton bearing date January Court 1838, we the undersigned Commissioners did on the 24th day of February 1838 (after giving sufficient notice) let to the lowest bidder the rebuilding of the Cypress bridge, when Patrick Dole undertook the rebuilding of the said bridge for the price of Seven hundred and ninety nine dollars, which will more fully appear by reference to the annexed Contract. And your Commissioners further report that the said Bridge has been completed by the said Patrick Dole according to the aforesaid Contract, and that we have received the said Bridge for the public use. All of which we respectfully submit to the Court - J. W. Thomas, Henry Blon. J. P. Nicholson."

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Tarapin bridge this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit: "Agreeably to an order of the County Court of Southampton bearing date February Court 1838 and thereto annexed. We the undersigned Commissioners named in said Order of Court have proceeded to let to the lowest undertaker the Tarapin bridge to be repaired in such manner as we think necessary and Edwin Williford became the undertaker for the sum of Twenty three dollars and 75^{cts}, which work is completed agreeable to Contract. Given under our hands this 5th day of June 1838 - Benj. L. Drew, Josiah D. McDell."

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of Smiths bridge this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit: "Agreeably to an order of the Worshipful Court of Southampton County bearing date - Court 1837, directing us to let the repairs of Smiths bridge across the three creeks. We the undersigned did on the 16th day of August let the same to Henry Bellway for the sum of Seventy two dollars & fifty cents which was completed according to Contract. Given under our hands this 16th June 1838 Spradley Williams, Tho. Ridley Sr."

Thugars Linn Curator of Catharine Linn who was directed to make ^{sale} of a negro woman and three children belonging to that said Catharine Linn, this day made his report which is approved of by the Court & ordered to be recorded, and is in these words to wit: "By virtue of the within order, the undersigned after giving Ten days notice of the time and place of said sale did sell at public auction on a Credit of twelve months, the 3rd day of March 1838, the above named negroes specified in the order, for one thousand one hundred & seventy dollars & twenty five cents, and a bond taken for the above and from Ruffin Hart with Allen Stephens security - Thugars Linn Curator of Catharine Linn."
