Rice who made oath and together with Henry Moore and Peter Edwards his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Miled Widdow deceased in due form -

Ordered that Joseph Darden, Richard Porter, Henry Moore and John Newton or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Miled Widdow deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

The Court doth assign Jacob Williams guardian to Elizabeth Williams orphan of William Williams deceased and thereupon the said Jacob Williams with John Sharp and Mills L. Gray his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to Law -

Richard P. Beammell orphan of James Beammell deceased with the approbation of the Court made choice of Walter Mayfield for his guardian who together with James Mayfield and Elizabeth D. Barham his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four hundred dollars conditioned according to Law -

On the motion of Etheldreda Warren it is ordered that he be exempt from the payment of Taxes and services in future for his negro slave George being aged and infirm -

Thomas J. Bruster is appointed Surveyor of the round-hill road in the room of James C. Clayton removed, and it is ordered that the usual bonds do not thereon -

Ordered that Master Commissioner Kold examine State and settle an additional account of William Harmons administration on the estate of James C. Harmons deceased and report the same to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state -

The last Will and Testament of Rebecca Simmons deceased was proved by the oaths of Zebulon L. Simmons and Henry Pethway two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. and Benjamin Applewhite the Executor therein named appeared in Court and refused to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof. On the motion of Nicholas M. Sebrill who made oath and together with Benjamin Applewhite, William J. Sebrill and John W. Parley his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Rebecca Simmons deceased with this Will annexed in due form -

Ordered that River Barker, John James, Jesse Little, and Zebulon L. Simmons or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Rebecca Simmons deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court -
