This cause came on this day to be heard by consent of parties, in the bill, and answer
and was argued by Counsel. The Court adjudged, order and decree
that Benjamin Griffin who is hereby appointed Commissioner for the purposes aforesaid
to sell on a credit of six months with the exception of One hundred dollars, and so much
burden as may be necessary to defray the expenses of this suit, and the execution of this decree,
which are required to be paid in cash, after giving up first fifteen days notice of the time
and place to be held at three or more public places in the County, the negroes Emma and
her child Dennis of which James Rouse died possessed and after the expenses of this suit and
decree as aforesaid divide the said sum of money into four equal parts and allot the
same as follows. One fourth part to the complainant William Rouse, and one fourth
part to each of the guardians of the infant complainants Sally Rouse, John Rouse Irving Rouse,
Mary Rouse, Henry Rouse, and Robert Rouse; and for the proceeds of so much of the said
sale as shall be made on a credit of six months as aforesaid the said Commissioner is
required to take bonds with good and sufficient security from the purchaser or purchasers
payable to the said William Rouse and the guardians of the said infant complainants
in the proportions aforesaid; and that he make report of his proceedings to this Court with the
view to a final decree.

On the motion of Bennett Munroe who made oath and together with Peter Edwards and
Richard Porter his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One
thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted him for obtaining
letters of administration on the estate of Sally Munroe deceased in due form.

Ordered that Matthew Commissioner do examine, state and settle an account of James D
Bryant's administration on the estate of Robert H. Beale dec. and report the same to the Court with
any matters specially stated demands, payments by himself or which he may be required to state.
