The Commissioners appointed to set apart and allot to Maria Parker by proper notes and bounds, the lands devised to her by the Will of her deceased husband Harrison Parker this day made their report which is confirmed by the Court and ordered to be recorded and as in these words to wit: "I do hereby certify to an order of the County Court of Southampton bearing date February 18th 1838: and hereto annexed in the undersigned Commissioners have allotted and set apart to Maria Parker widow and relict of Harrison Parker dec^d by proper notes and bounds The lands devised to her by late husband, and which is marked and bounded as follows. Beginning at a pine at the run of the Cedar Swamp in John Cotts line thence nearly a West course to a marked Persimmon Tree standing on the South side of the dwelling house, thence in nearly the same direction to another Persimmon Tree marked as a corner, thence nearly due West by the lot gate and along a line of marked Trees to a gum at the road leading from South Quay to Henric ferry, a corner of George Williams and the line of the said Harrison Parker dec^d thence along the subboundary lines of the said Tract or parcel of lands, of which this is a part, called and known by the name of the Green Tract as named and designated by the said Harrison Parkers Will.
