The Court doth assign Thomas Lawrence guardian to Joanna Schubert Johnson orphan of Schab Johnson deceased and thereupon he together with Elisha Gardner and Jonathan Gardner his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.
