Let \$275. to River Barker. Martha \$400. William 275- 675

By consent it is ordered that the Indentures by which William, of Brindshaw, is bound to Thomas Linn, be transferred to Jacob Linn and they are hereby transferred.

Nancy Whitney the Executrix named in the will of David Whitney dec^d heretofore proved and recorded in this Court, this day appeared in Court and took the oath and together with Mary L. Whitney and Catharine Whitney her securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Six thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted her for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form. Liberty being awarded for the Executor thereof named to be joined in the said probate when he shall see fit.

Ordered that James Jones Joshua Harrod and all former being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do approve and the personal estate of David Whitney dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
