ordered that the said Ridley have leave to alter the said road and when the same be opened  
and put in good repair that the old road be discontinued.

A Certificate of the qualification of John M. Gurley Commissioner of the Revenue was returned  
and ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit: "Southampton County Court. John  
M. Gurley Commissioner of the Revenue in St. Lukes Parish in the County aforesaid appeared  
before me and took the oath necessary for his qualification - Given under my hand this 1<sup>st</sup>  
day of February 1829. - Lord P. Nicholson J.P." To the County Court of Southampton?

This day came the parties by their Counsel and the Commissioner appointed by the interlocutory  
decree made in this cause at October Term last to sell the tract of land in the bill mentioned made  
report in the following words to wit: "In conformity to the annexed decree the undersigned did  
on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October 1828, after giving due notice as by the decree I was directed, sell to  
the highest bidder the tract of land mentioned in said decree on a credit of six months, and  
Williams H. Corbett became the purchaser for the sum of One hundred & six dollars & 25 cents  
I have deducted from this amount two dollars 65 cents which is 2 1/2 % of the purchase money, and  
eleven dollars and 32 cents for the Lawyers & Clerks fees, making \$13 92 cents as the  
whole of the expenses attending the sale - this sum taken from the net amount say \$106.25 cts  
leaves \$92.28 cts which I have divided into four equal parts, making \$23.07 cts each  
Childs part for which I have taken four separate bonds with good security, one bond to William  
H. Corbett for \$23.07 cts one ditto to Nancy Ann Corbett for the same amount, one to Samuel Corbett  
for the same amount, and one other to Joshua Corbett for the same amount, all of which I have  
ready to pay to pay over, to their legal guardians when they are appointed. Given under my  
hand this 26<sup>th</sup> day of October 1828. A Deny Bresson Commissioner." On consideration  
whereof and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered, that the sale and division aforesaid  
in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and binding forever between  
the parties.
