On the motion of William L. Everett for leave to alter the road leading from flat Swamp bridge to Haley's bridge commencing in the land on the land belonging to the estate of Benjamin Turner dec. thence near Stinson's Meetinghouse and thence to the said old road Ordered that John H. Reese, Nathaniel Francis, Hewitt Drew, Turner Westbrook and Benjamin Ellis or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do view the way proposed for running the new road as well as the present way and report to the Court the comparative convenience and inconvenience that will result as well to individuals as to the public if such alteration be made as is proposed.

On the motion of Henry Kindred who made oath and together with Peter Edwards and Nathaniel Simmons his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars Conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of James Pope deceased in due form.

Ordered that Burwell Bryant, William S. Bryant, Sampson O. Reese and James Powell or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of James Pope deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that the estate of Charlotte Applowhite dec. be committed to the hands of James D. Massenburg, Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.

On the motion of Adam Woolfram setting forth that he is bound in this Court as security for James Edwards for his due and faithful administration of the estate of Joseph Edwards dec. and that he conceives himself to be in danger of suffering damages by reason thereof It is ordered that the said James Edwards be summoned to the first day of the next Term to show cause, if any he can, why he should not be ruled to give to the said Adam Woolfram good counter security or execute a new bond with security according to law.

John Westbrook who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the complaint of Jacob Ramsey against him for a breach of the peace this day appeared in discharge of his recognizance. And thereupon the said Jacob Ramsey being sworn and examined and the said John Westbrook fully heard, it is the opinion of the Court and accordingly ordered that the said John Westbrook give security for his keeping the peace for the space of twelve months from this day himself to be bound in the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars with two securities in the sum of Seventy five dollars each. Whereupon the said John Westbrook together with Peter D. Beckman and John C. Turner his securities here in Court severally acknowledge themselves indebted unto his Excellency David Campbell Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say the said John Westbrook in the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars and the said Beckman and Turner in the sum of Seventy five dollars each, of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered.
