

On the motion of John C. Beale. Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine, take and settle an account of the said John C. Beale's administration on Rebecca Beale's estate and report the same to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state -

An Inventory and Appraisement of John Vaughn's estate was returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Nicholas M. Sebell. Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine, take and settle an account of the said Sebell's administration on Nancy A. Sebell's estate and report the same to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Parker and Joseph Stanton has deposed entered into and acknowledged a bond on the penalty of Twenty five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. Ordered that Nathaniel Moore, Henry Pethway, Solomon D. Parker and Joseph Stanton or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of William L. Rochelle dec. and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
