This cause came on this day to be heard by consent of parties, on the bill and answer and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that Edwin Smith, who is hereby appointed Commissioner for the purpose, do proceed to sell, after giving at least twenty days notice of the time and place of sale, of three or more Battle places in the County, the tract of land of which William R Battle died seized and possessed, being the same tract that was set apart by a decree of the County Court of Southampton as and for his proportion of the said land, to Magot in the land of which his father Nicholas Magot said seized and possessed on a credit of six months, except so much as may be necessary to defray the expenses of this suit, which he will require to be paid in cash, and that for the residue thereof he take five bonds with good and sufficient security to be made payable as follows: One bond for the seventh part thereof to the defendant Mary Jane Battle, one bond for one fourth of the remaining six months payable to the guardian of the infant Complainant James H Battle; one bond for one fourth to the guardian of the infant Complainant Nicholas J Battle, one bond for another fourth to the guardian of the infant Complainant Ann Eliza Battle and another bond for the remaining fourth to the guardian of the Complainant John Battle and that he make report to this Court with the view to a final decree.
