The boundaries of which will particularly appear in the plat and survey herewith returned and requested to be taken as a part of this report. Given under our hands this 17 day of June Eighteen hundred and thirty nine. J. D. M. Applingburg, Thos. Trotter, John Davis. Our considerations whereof and by consent of the parties by their counsel, it is deemed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be confirmed.
