Ordered that A. S. H. Wargal, Thurgate Lam and Joseph Vandort or any two of them let the building of a bridge and Causeway across the old pond branch, receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Harrison P. Pope who is charged on oath by Clementina Brutt, single woman of this County with being the father of her bastard child this day appeared in Court, and thereupon the said Clementina Brutt being sworn and examined and the said Harrison P. Pope fully heard, this Court upon the whole circumstances of the case, doth adjudge the said Harrison P. Pope to be the father of the said bastard child and that the said child is likely to become chargeable to the County. Therefore it is ordered that the said Harrison P. Pope be charged with the annual payment of Seventeen dollars and fifty cents to the Overseers of the Poor of the said County for the space of seven years from the 1st day of September last, in case the said child shall live so long; and that the said Harrison P. Pope pay the same to them accordingly at the end of every year until the expiration of the said seven years. And thereupon the said Harrison P. Pope with Benjamin Pope and John M. Gurley his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to David Campbell Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Harrison P. Pope in the sum of One hundred and twenty two dollars & fifty cents and the said Benjamin Pope and John M. Gurley in the sum of thirty one dollars twenty five cents each of their respective goods and chattels lands and Tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Harrison P. Pope shall serve and perform the above order of the Court made against him as aforesaid then the above obligation to be void & else to remain in full force and virtue -

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term -
