

Resolved that these proceedings be spread upon the records of this Court, and that a copy be forwarded by the Clerk to the widow of the deceased and another copy be inserted in the Richmond and Petersburg gazettes.

Ordered that Henry Pethum, Joseph Blanton and Rowland Thomas or any two of them do let to the Court and make the repairs of the bridge across the mill race of Mr. Edmund M. Watkins, the bridge below Little George Wood mill, and also another bridge near the one last named, receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

A. M. Seibell and Samuel P. Nicholson two of the Justices of the Peace for this County this day returned the following certificate to the Court.

Sauchen Plains County to wit: We the Justices A. M. Seibell and Samuel P. Nicholson three Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid, having upon due examination before us had of Arthur Senter of this County, been of opinion that he was a person of unsound mind, and that it was expedient he should be removed to the public hospital for the maintenance and Cure of Persons of unsound mind in the City of Williamsburg, and having accordingly directed him to be so removed by our order bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June last past, we do therefore hereby certify the same to the Court of this County together with the annexed Certificate of the estate of the said Arthur Senter, which is all that has yet come to our knowledge. Witness our hand this day of 1829. A. M. Seibell, Lem P. Nicholson, J. P. The said Arthur Senter has no property.

On the motion of Adams Ford who made oath and together with Charles M. Scott and Seth Williams his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of forty dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Deborah Bryant de<sup>d</sup> in due form.

Ordered that Charles M. Scott, Seth Williams and Arthur Cobb being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Deborah Bryant de<sup>d</sup> and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Mary Freeman widow of Charles Freeman deceased relinquished her right to the administration of her deceased husbands estate in favour of Samuel H. Holmes. And on the motion of the said Samuel H. Holmes who made oath and together with John P. Whitting and James Clayton his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Charles Freeman de<sup>d</sup> in due form.

Ordered that Sadrupus, Thomas M. Bailey and John P. Whitting being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Charles Freeman de<sup>d</sup> and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
