On the 29th of the same month the said bridge was let out to the lowest undertaker & Joseph P. Barrows became the owner as thirty four dollars, we have since examined the bridge and find the work faithfully done agreeable to contract. Theodore Tregent, N. M. Cobell. July 1839."

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of three bridges this day made report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit: "Pursuant to an order from the Worshipful Court of Southampton County bearing date October Court 1838. to us directed, we the undersigned Commissioners after giving notices of the time and place let to the lowest undertaker the rebuilding of three bridges across the three creeks as expressed in said order for which work David Drury became contractor for the sum of five hundred dollars and has since been completed agreeable to contract. Given under our hands this 13th day of May 1839. Thos. P. Barrows John Drury David Preece. Commissioners."
